JOB DESCRIPTION:

The Cooperative offers local telephone, cellular telephone, wireless and dial-up Internet, and cable TV. The Outside Plant Technician is involved in all of these services and divides his time between office and field work, requiring travel to Alaska Native villages.

The Technician installs, maintains, tests and repairs all types of cable facilities, related equipment, key systems and other associated equipment. The Technician also clears trouble, installs subscriber carrier systems, maintains necessary records, provides reports, completes requests for new service, determines methodology for installing telephone service, determines appropriateness of equipment changes or modifications, tests trunks, tests links, and installs communication circuits. May lead the work of others. Reports to a project leader or manager.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED:

EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE:

Knowledge and skills usually acquired through technical and electronics training, and a minimum of two years of experience in telephone/cable plant operations or related field. A wide degree of creativity and latitude is expected. AutoCad experience desired.

JOB KNOWLEDGE / RELATED SKILLS:

Understanding of basic electronics, specification sheets and circuit diagrams. Knowledge of telco plant operations, regulatory/industry standards and procedures, and new switching and plant technologies. Understanding of plant testing techniques and equipment. Use of mechanical and electrical power tools. Ability/willingness to handle heavy physical workload, including climbing, lifting and stooping; to pay close attention to detail, instructions and schedules; to respond to customers and community to ensure positive public relations and to retain customer identification with the telco. Must be able to use a computer and be familiar with Microsoft Office and other applications.
